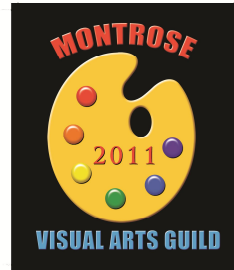

Her artwork has earned Merit Awards and shown at juried shows throughout the United States including the Oil Painters of America Show, CM Russell Art Show and Arts for the Parks-Top 100. She was been featured in *Southwest Art Magazine's* Best of the West, *Cowboys and Indians Magazine*, *International Artist Magazine-Master Artists* and *American Artist Workshop Magazine*. Her work has been in the *Richeson Art Book Series* and the plein air book *Sun on My Back, Dust on My Shoes*. She has also been on staff at the Denver Art Museum teaching color theory, composition and painting.

ELIGIBILITY FOR THE SHOW:

Because this is a non-juried show, competition is open to all artists. Works must be original, and not shown at previous MVAG shows. No class work, painting done in a workshop, or prints accepted. Copied works are not considered original.

Rulings on classification and eligibility are the responsibility of the Show Committee, which also reserves the right to refuse to display unsuitable entries.

ACCEPTED MEDIA

Oil/acrylic (O/A), watermedia (WC), graphics (G), pastel (P), multimedia (MM), sculpture (S)

SALES AND LIABILITY:

All entries must be priced for sale and **may not be removed before the close of the exhibit**. The Guild will handle all sales and will charge a 30% commission. MVAG and the Camelot Gardens will take reasonable precautions against damage and theft; however, neither will assume further responsibility. Artists are responsible for their own insurance. Entering this show signifies agreement to these terms.

GIFT SHOP:

Any artist entered in the show may also have up to six works (each priced at \$100 or less) displayed in the Gift Shop for a total fee of \$5.

AWARDS:

Best of Show MVAG Award--\$200, People's Choice Award--\$200, Montrose Art Council Award--\$250, First Place--\$50.

RIBBONS:

1ST, 2ND, 3RD, and Honorable Mention will be awarded at the Judge's discretion.

CATEGORIES:

Land/Seascape(interior/exterior); Floral/Still Life; Portrait/Figures; Animal/Wildlife; Abstract; Sculpture.

SKILL LEVELS:

Professional--P, Advanced--Ad, Amateur--Am, and Student --S (up to grade 12/18 years old) levels.

Definitions

Amateur: Not necessarily actively involved in selling artwork, prefers a relaxed approach to exhibits and competitions, may be continuing his/her art education.

Advanced: Interested in improving artistic skills, may be beginning to develop a portfolio for approaching galleries, enters regional shows, sells a few pieces of art a year.

Professional: Has a degree in art, teaches or has taught for pay, two (2) or more blue ribbons as Advanced within the past two (2) years, or is represented by a gallery.

Classification is a reflection of how each artist perceives his/her own abilities. We offer these definitions as a guide for artists entering the MVAG show. Factors requiring an artist to move up from Amateur to Advanced or from Advanced to Professional include winning two (2) or more blue ribbons at one level within the past two (2) years and/or the judge's recommendation that the artist should move up the following year.

SPECIAL THEME:

The HANDS theme will include all media. Artists may enter one work in this division by using entry number seven (7) ON THE REGISTRATION FORM. Only one entry allowed in this division.

ENTRIES & FEES:

A total of seven entries may be submitted, one of which may be in the Special Division. Each entry must have a fully completed label attached. **FEES:** MEMBER: \$25 for first three entries and \$5 for each additional entry; NON-MEMBER: \$30 for first three entries and \$5 for each additional entry; and STUDENT: \$1 each entry. **NOTE: If you have not paid dues to MVAG for 2011, you are not a member.** Cost to join the guild for 2011 is \$25.00 (\$12.50 after June).

FRAMING:

Artwork must be framed and have wire for hanging—no saw tooth hangers. **No exceptions!** Final size of artwork, including frame may not exceed 60" on any side. Art work weighing over 70 pounds will be rejected.
